## WHY POMEGRANATES?

#### INTRODUCTION BY ILIYANA NEDKOVA AND WENDY TIMMONS



We are delighted to welcome you to Pomegranates Finale 2025 - a double bill of dance, music, poetry and masks, including *Hidden Faces* directed by **Jonzi D** and cochoreographed by **Emma Ready and Sean Edwards**, preceded by the curtain-raiser **Sequins** performed and choreographed by **Kalubi Mukengela-Jacoby**. A Festival finale sowing the seeds and sequins of international traditional dance in Scotland and culminating in the celebration of UNESCO's International Dance Day (29 April).

Rewinding back to the Pomegranates Festival spoken word commission *Sequins of Poems to Dance To* by **Ian McMillan**, the curtain-raiser *Sequins* is a new solo by **Kalubi Mukengela-Jacoby**, which fuses the alphabet of traditional Congolese dance with hip hop rhythm, haunting soundscapes and spoken word.

In tune with the Pomegranates Festival 2025 theme, this year's finale *Hidden Faces* explores the power of masks used in different traditions. It follows two days of workshopping and acquiring the skills, techniques and confidence of masked dancing, while reflecting on the beauty and mystery of masks in traditional dance from antiquity to modern days, including Venetian Friulian, Tarantella, Buso, Tibetan Opera, Chinese Nuo, Bellydance, Zaouli, Commedia dell'Arte and Hip Hop Breaking.

Just like in the first three years of the Pomegranates Festival, the finale is the outcome of two intensive days of professional development workshops led by artists and creative migrants based in Scotland, including Tamar, Alena Shmakova, Monica di Ioanni, Inesa Vėlavičiūtė, Árpád Vörös, Krisztina & Zsuzsanna Szabone, Yuxi Jiang, Yifeng Zhu, Kalubi Mukengela-Jacoby, Sean Edwards and Emma Ready.

In addition, *Hidden Faces* is inspired by Venice - the city that gave birth to Antonio Vivaldi and to the mask and merry-making tradition known as the Venice Carnival. The show thus becomes the first opportunity for the newly-commissioned masks by our festival artist-in-residence **Lorraine Pritchard,** Scotland's only mask-maker trained in the Venetian style, to come alive on the stage, dancing to the music of the Venetian maestro Vivaldi and coming to a close with the rapping coda by **Sean Edwards:** 

We call the masks of the world,
We call the faces of the soul,
We stand between them —
and we welcome what wants to be revealed.
The masks have spoken,
the faces have danced,
the soul has been seen.
We give thanks.
We release all back to the Mystery.
